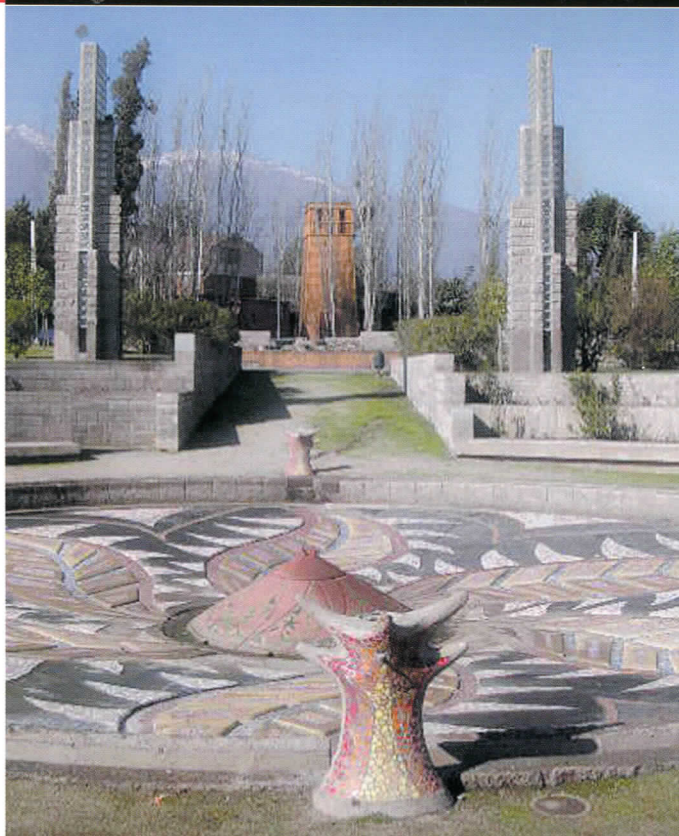




Parque por la Paz Villa Grimaldi Park for Peace

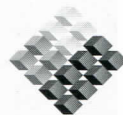
VILLA GRIMALDI, located in the municipality of Peñalolén in Santiago de Chile, was used as a detention, torture and execution center under the military regime. Of the 4,500 prisoners who were held here between 1973 and 1978, 226 are listed as "disappeared".

VILLA GRIMALDI, a symbol of cruelty, repression and violence, became the PARQUE POR LA PAZ ("PARK FOR PEACE"): a historical memorial, a site for reflection, a meeting place and symbol of peace, justice and human rights' defense and promotion, thanks to the efforts of both the community and the Government of Chile.

In April 2004, the Parque por la Paz Villa Grimaldi was declared Historical Monument by the Ministry of Education.
